

## Red Wine Selection

*Penfolds Private Release Shiraz Cab*

Red currant and summer berry nose. Medium bodied with youthful strawberry, raspberry and loganberry fruit. Fine tannins ensure a soft and rounded mouthfeel.

*Seppelt Victorian Shiraz*

Different style to the Shiraz grown in warmer climates of Australia. Excellent vintage conditions have led to a fine, elegant, peppery Shiraz, that delivers rich sweet fruit and fine soft tannins, but also a savoury finish.

*Devils Lair Fifth Leg Red (blend)*

A deliciously irritable number from Western Australia, elegance, finesse, and complexity are the characteristics which set Devils Lair and Fifth Leg apart. It has a concentrated fruit focused nose with a complex array of dark berry and chocolate aromas, supported by well integrated cedary oak. Juicy on the pallet, cherries and plums from the tender Merlot, the underlying chocolaty ness of the subtle oak combines with a lovely Shiraz spice

*Pepperjack Cabernet Sauvignon*

Plum red in the glass. Aromas of blackcurrant and spice develop into an elegant palate with hints of mint and cedar. A rich full-bodied wine offering great structure and balance with a backbone of cedary oak and well-integrated tannins. Enjoy Pepperjack with mint and rosemary infused roasts.

*Penfolds Kalimna Shiraz Bin 28*

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Deep, dark red. The nose initially exhibits a vibrant mix of dark fruits fused with notes of dark chocolate, cola, anise, liquorice and a skerrick of vanillin. A swirl of the glass teases out violet nuances, overhanging wafts of cold cured meats and scents of the sultana/raisin dough portion of a boiled fruitcake mixture. Very clear, ripe fruit definition whilst young, with plenty of concentration, fruit sweetness, and minimal oak influence

*Coldstream Hills Merlot 2005*

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Lifted aromas of red and blue berries, brown spice, violet, black olives and blonde tobacco. A wine for the synaesthete perhaps. The oak is fairly subtle with attractive vanilla and cedar characters. On the palate medium bodied with sour edged red fruits and savoury tobacco and olive flavours. Typically varietal. Slightly sappy acidity and light grainy tannins. Finishes dry with sour berry and black olive flavours.

*Wynns Coonawarra Estate Cab Sav*

Bouquets are initially subdued, but develop into wafts of berries and earth, tar and ribena. Marvelously soft and fruity on the palate, a distinguished wine offering great amounts of cassis and earthy cedary wood notes, blackberries, hints of truffle and blueberry, all that you'd expect from the exceptional Coonawarra Cabernet vines. This vintage is generous and very straightforward, there are welcome sprigs of incredibly fresh mint, more tart and sour elements of sweet cassis and cherry, flavours like baked plum, ala mode with liquorice ice cream, and backed by the dusty cedar and vanillan oak. It's soft and fleshy, helped along by an oaky palate and finishes with soft, slightly timid tannins, smooth like old comfortable suede.
